

How do I get eBooks for my Kindle from the Jericho Library?

Jericho Library is proud to introduce the *Overdrive Advantage Collection*. Overdrive Advantage is designed to allow us to add **more popular titles specifically for Jericho cardholders only**. This means eBooks titles will be available with a shorter wait time or even the day you log in! Sign in to take Advantage of the additional copies that have been added for Jericho cardholders, Look for the following logo:



1. If you have a Fire, you may begin by connecting to a Wi-Fi network and opening your Fire's browser. For all other Kindles, you **must** begin on a computer. Go to the Jericho Public Library website: www.jericholibrary.org/
2. Click on the Overdrive icon twice. This is where you will browse and check out Kindle eBooks:



3. Next, click on "Advanced Search" (located on the right side of the screen):

4. Click on the drop down menu for "Format" and choose "Kindle Book." You may choose to check the "Only show available titles" box. Begin searching for Kindle titles by clicking the "Search" box. When you find an available title click on the Kindle Book "Add to Cart" icon.



5. Once you "Add to Cart" and "Proceed to Checkout," you will be asked to choose Jericho library & input your library card number.

6. Click the 'Get for Kindle' button. This opens the Amazon website. You will be required to sign in with an Amazon account.

7. Before you click the 'Get library book' button, make sure to choose the proper Kindle device or Kindle App in order to ensure delivery. **Keep in mind, if you are using the Kindle App, you must first register the app to your amazon account! Otherwise you will not be given the option to deliver via the app.** Once you confirm where the title will be delivered, click the "Get library book" button. A confirmation screen that the eBook has been downloaded will appear.

In order to sync the eBook to your Kindle device or Kindle app, please keep in mind there are specific steps to follow depending on your Kindle. Please read further to determine how to proceed:

If you are downloading to the Kindle dx, or if you cannot access your WiFi, skip to step 9.

If you are using the Kindle Fire, skip to step 10.

If you are downloading via the Kindle App, skip to step 11.

For all other Kindles, go to step 8.

8. An active Wi-Fi connection is required for wireless delivery to a Wi-Fi enabled Kindle. To set-up the Wi-Fi:

* Press the Home button then press the Menu button.

* Navigate to "Settings" and select "Wi-Fi Settings" to show available Wi-Fi networks.

* Select a public or private Wi-Fi network. If you are at the Jericho Library choose "Jericho Public Library." If you are at home, choose your home network. At home, you may be required to enter a password that your internet provider created. It will be a string of numbers and letters.

* If you connected to the Jericho Wi-Fi, you will be prompted to open your browser. To logon type your e-mail address into the "Guests: Your email address" box located on the upper left hand side of your screen.

* Once connected, your Kindle will begin to automatically sync with your amazon account and the eBook you checked out should begin downloading.

9. **Kindle dx or WiFi connection issues:** If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection read Amazon's instructions and watch the video about how to Transfer files via USB.

10. **Kindle Fire:** Once you have downloaded the eBook, press your settings icon, and then press the 'sync' button. Once synced, the eBook title will appear on your home screen.

11. **Kindle App:** Once you have chosen to deliver via the Kindle app on your smart phone, iPad, or PC, return to your home screen (or in the case of your PC, the desktop) and open up your Kindle App. Then, simply click on the sync icon. The eBook will have downloaded to your "Archived Items."
