

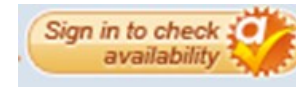
How do I get eBooks for my Nook from the

Jericho Library is proud to introduce the *Overdrive Advantage Collection*. Overdrive Advantage is designed to allow us to add **more popular titles specifically for Jericho cardholders only**. This means eBooks titles will be available with a shorter wait time or even the day you log in! While browsing the catalog, login to take Advantage of the additional copies that have been added for Jericho cardholders, when you see the following logo:



1. For all Nook e-readers, you **must** begin on a computer. Go to the Jericho Public Library website: www.jericholibrary.org/

2. Click on the Overdrive icon twice.



3. The first step is to download the Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software. Once on the "Nassau Digital Doorway" website click on "Digital Software" on the left of the screen, then "Adobe Digital Editions."

4. Click the "Get Adobe Digital Editions" button towards the top of the page. Then scroll down and click "Install" twice.

5. A window will pop up with a message, "Press yes to download and continue the installation..." click "Yes."

6. A new window will pop up with the message, "Check the components you want to install..." click "Next."

7. A third window will pop up with the message, "Setup will install Adobe Digital Editions..." click "Install." When the download is

complete click "Close."

8. A new window will pop up with the message, "This installer will setup Adobe Digital Editions. Please review..." click "I Agree."

9. The ADE software will open the "Setup Assistant." Click "Continue" to start the Setup Assistant.

10. You will be prompted for an Adobe ID. If you do not already have an Adobe ID, click "Get an Adobe ID online" at the end of the fourth line. *If you already have an Adobe ID skip to step 13.*

11. You will be redirected to www.Adobe.com. Click on "Create an Adobe Account."

12. On the "Join Adobe" page, fill out the required fields and click "Continue."

13. Return to the ADE software and enter the user name and password you just created. Click "Activate" and then "Finished."

14. You will now need to return to the Nassau Digital Doorway website to download an eBook.

15. Browse for a title that is in the "Adobe EPUB eBook" format, and has the option "Add to Cart." To borrow the eBook click "Add to Cart."

16. Click "Proceed to Checkout."

17. Sign in by choosing "Jericho Public Library," and entering your library barcode. Click "Confirm Check out."

18. Click "Download" located underneath the cover of the eBook.

19. You will have the option to save or open, choose "Save File." We recommend creating an "eBook" folder on the desktop and saving all eBooks in this folder.

20. A new window appears prompting: save or cancel. Click "Save." Remember to save to the eBook folder you just created.

21. ADE will automatically open with the eBook downloading.

22. Once the eBook is downloaded, plug your Nook into the computer using the USB cable. (You will be asked if you want to see the files. Simply click "Cancel.")

23. The first time your Nook is connected with ADE open, you will be asked to authorize your Nook. *You must authorize your Nook with ADE software to be able to transfer and read eBooks.*

24. Once authorized, you should see your Nook listed on the left side at the bottom of ADE. If you don't see your Nook listed, click on Library View on the top left (it looks like a shelf of books).

25. The eBook you just downloaded will appear on the right side of ADE. Simply click on the eBook and drag and drop it to your Nook within ADE. Wait until it is copied fully to your Nook, as indicated by the progress bar.

26. Disconnect your Nook. You may now begin reading a Nassau Digital Doorway eBook on your Nook.

Having trouble locating the eBook on your Nook? eBooks downloaded from the Nassau Digital Doorway are generally located in your Library under "My Files" and then "Digital Editions."
