How can we protect them? Learn all about bees and make a craft to take home.

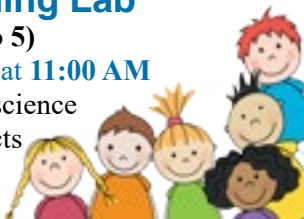


### Library Learning Lab
