### **What is Freading?**

Freeding is an eBook service like Overdrive. All you need to access this new service is your Jericho library card. Access this free service through [www.jericholibrary.org](http://www.jericholibrary.org) and look for the Freeding logo.

### **Do the titles I check out from Freeding interfere with my Overdrive account?**

No, they are separate services. Therefore, eBooks titles you check out from Freeding are counted **only** toward your Freeding account. Any title you checkout from Overdrive counts **only** toward their 5 title limit.

### **How long can I checkout an eBook? Are there late fines?**

You may check out a Freeding eBook for 14 days. There are no fines or charges.

### **How many eBooks can I download?**

Freeding eBooks are downloaded via a token system. You have a weekly allotment of 6, which appears in the upper right hand corner of the home page after you login. When you choose a book, the amount of tokens labeled on the book is deducted from your account.

### **How do I know how many tokens an eBook is worth?**

There are three different token values assigned to eBook downloads: 4, 2 or 1 token(s). In most cases newly published books are 4 tokens. After a period of time they drop to 2, eventually dropping to 1. So in general, the token value is based on how new a book is.

### **Why do I have more than 6 tokens to use?**

Unused tokens roll over each week until the end of the month. At the end of the month, unused tokens are removed from your account, except for your original weekly allotment of six.

### **Can I renew my eBooks?**

Yes! Once the 14 days have expired, you can renew a book by searching for the title again. You will see that the token value has changed. The amount of tokens to renew, if any, are displayed. You can click the download link. Downloading it will renew the eBook for an additional 14 days.

### **How many eBooks titles are available to download?**

It changes daily as new titles are always being added. But there are many books in different genres.

### **Can I download these eBooks to my tablet or smart phone? What software or apps do I need?**

Yes, Freading eBooks can be transferred to the following devices by using Adobe Digital Editions: all Barnes & Noble Nooks and all Sony Readers. You can also read the eBooks on your computer with Adobe Digital Editions.

You will need to download the Freading app for iPads, iPhones, and Android based smart phones. Currently for Kindle users, **only** the Kindle Fire can download Freading eBooks. Refer to the instructions in the FAQ's under "How do I get the Freading app on the Kindle Fire."

### **I only downloaded two eBooks, but can't download anymore. Why not?**

A library-wide weekly download limit has also been set. If this limit is reached, you may add the eBooks to your "wish list" to download the following week.

### **What is my "wish list?"**

Your "wish list" is a saved list of eBooks that you may want to download in the future.
