How to Join the Library

Anyone who lives in the Jericho Union Free School District may become a library member. A photo identification and a second identification indicating your home address are required (driver's license, utility bill, etc.). You may check out three books until the Library card is received in the mail. A yellow Preschool Program Registration card will be given to children from birth to 4 years of age. Children may have a library card when they are five years old. The child must be accompanied by a parent who shows the correct identification and proof of the child's age (birth certificate or passport).

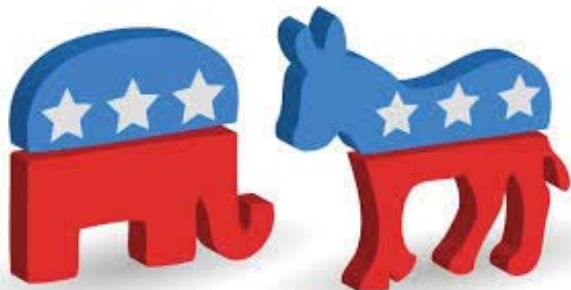

There are no primary elections to be held in New York in 2017.

General Election

Tuesday, November 7, 2017

To vote, you must be a registered voter in the general or primary elections. To register, you must be a United States citizen, be 18 years old by the date of the election you want to vote, live at your present address for at least 30 days before an election, not be in jail or on parole for a felony conviction, and not claim the right to vote elsewhere.
