DOWNLOADING MINECRAFT:

1. Go to your device’s App Store.
2. In the search bar, enter “Minecraft.”
3. There should be a box under the “Minecraft” app that reads “\$6.99.” Please click on the price tag.
4. Pay for the app. Once the payment is successful, you can proceed to download the app. As a reminder, you can play on Minecraft for free on the computer if you don’t wish to buy the app.
5. Once Minecraft is finished downloading, please open the app.
6. You will have the option to Sign In. Please choose to Sign In with a Microsoft account. If you do not have a Microsoft / XBOX account (they’re the same thing), please create one or let the host know you’re in need of an account (we can provide up to 15). You will need to be signed-in to connect to our program, and it’s free to sign up.
7. Once you have signed up, please click “Multiplayer” and then click “Servers.”
8. Server information will be provided when you join the zoom and session!
